## Goals:

- Varied, meaningful experiences early and often
- Streamline placements while maintaining compliance (e.g., SPED and Minnesota)
- Provide a year-long experience
- Embed an apprenticeship model with flexible methods for demonstrating competency
- Begin the TPA earlier to improve on-time completion and graduation rates

**APPRENTICESHIP MODEL**- Within each clinical course (and within clinical experiences in ProCore and Methods), we need to have the ability to support candidates already working in a classroom. We will not have separate courses for these candidates, but have varying ways to demonstrate competency within the master curriculum.

- Only one placement instead of two
- Instead of watching a video in ProCore or Methods, where is it appropriate for them to watch their Mentor Teacher or actually teach the lesson. Must verify this experience.
- A mentor teacher "sign off" and verification of experiences they have already completed to demonstrate competency. (Early Clinical, part of Advanced Clinical)
- Student Teaching requirements stay the same, but they can complete the requirements in their same classroom.
